



ABOUT SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarships are designed for families that demonstrate a financial need and an interest in the arts.
- Applicant families must qualify for and participate in the free/reduced school lunch program and/or receive HEAP assistance, within the 2018-19 academic school year.
- Scholarships are limited to one camp session per child.
- Scholarships include full coverage of the camp registration fee and all tuition fees, totaling \$250 per child per week of summer camp.
- Scholarships are assigned in accordance with the Castellani Art Museum's mission: "The Castellani Art Museum of Niagara University connects diverse audiences to art by inspiring creativity and learning within the campus community and beyond."
- Funds for scholarships are limited and provided by private donations.
- Submitting a scholarship application does not guarantee a space in the summer camp program.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must submit:

- A completed application form.
- Documentation that the applicant family qualifies for and participates in the free/reduced school lunch program and/or receives HEAP assistance, within the 2018-19 academic school year.
- A letter of support from a mentor (teacher, pastor, rabbi, guidance counselor, coach, etc.) who is not a relative of the student, indicating the applicant's interest in the arts and commitment to the program.
- A parent/guardian must provide transportation for the student to/from the Castellani Art Museum for each day of camp (Monday-Friday) if they receive a scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications will be reviewed as submitted by the Scholarship Committee.
- Applications for summer camps will be accepted from April 1 until June 21, 2019.
- All participants will be notified of their application status by July 1, 2019.
- Applicants granted scholarship funds must confirm their attendance by July 8, 2019.
- Parents/guardians must complete required summer camp registration paperwork and provide up to date vaccination records, if awarded scholarship funds.
